

Visiting Tokanui Hospital Cemetery via AgResearch Farm...

AgResearch is committed to ensuring you have a safe visit to the Tokanui Hospital Cemetery. As access to the cemetery is via our working dairy farm we request that you read and observe the following guidelines and safety information:

Sign In/Out

All visitors **must** report to the Tokanui Farm office upon arrival to sign in (before proceeding to the cemetery site). If office is closed, please sign the Visitors Board.

Visitors are requested to also sign out at the office before leaving the farm.

Visiting Hours

Visiting hours are from 6am – 4.30pm daily (unless by prior arrangement).

Please note the farm gates are locked between 4.30pm - 5pm daily.

Directions & Parking

Please refer to the Tokanui Farm Map for directions and parking. We advise that you bring suitable footwear (waterproof) relative to the weather and ground conditions.

Hazards

Please watch for the following

- ❖ **Stock movements:** please be patient and give way to cows walking to/from dairy shed
- ❖ **Vehicular traffic:** including heavy machinery operating or moving
- ❖ **Uneven terrain:** please take care with footing when walking in paddock and cemetery
- ❖ **Electric fencing:** fencing may be electric, please treat as if it were live.
- ❖ **Tap Water:** water from tap at the cemetery site is not suitable for drinking.

General

Visitors to the cemetery are **NOT** permitted to wander to other areas of the farm unsupervised.

All farm vehicles, machinery, tools and equipment are strictly off limits to visitors.

No Alcohol or drugs are permitted on farm.

Rule on Farms – any gate **you** open, **you** must close.

Do not climb on fences/gates.

Do not approach livestock.

In the event of an emergency please assemble at the carpark located by the farm office.

Incidents/Accidents

Should you sustain an injury during your visit; first aid assistance can be sought at the Tokanui Farm office.

For **emergencies** please phone **111** (Farm address is 96 Farm Road, Kihikihi).

AgResearch request that any incidents/accidents that occur during your visit are reported to a member of staff.

All visitors should take reasonable precautions to ensure their own safety.
