

## Visiting Tokanui Hospital Cemetery via AgResearch Farm...

**ALERT!** Before coming out to visit the Tokanui Hospital Cemetery we ask that you refer to AgResearch's Farm Biosecurity Declaration put in place to prevent potential risk of Foot and Mouth outbreak. While currently outbreaks only occur overseas, there would likely be severe consequences for the Agricultural sector if it were to come into New Zealand. Accordingly we ask that if you cannot accept the conditions of this Declaration please do not enter AgResearch Tokanui Farm to visit the cemetery.

### Sign in/out

All visitors must report to the farm office upon arrival to sign in on the whiteboard outside the office door.

Visitors are requested to also sign out at the office before leaving the farm. This way we can ensure you do not get locked in.

### Visiting Hours

Visiting hours are from 7:00am – 4.30pm daily (unless by prior arrangement).

Please note the farm gates are locked at 4:30pm daily.

### Hazards

Please watch for the following

- ❖ **Gates and stock movements:** please be patient and give way to cows walking to/from dairy shed. Please leave gates as you found them
- ❖ **Vehicles:** including heavy machinery operating or moving
- ❖ **Uneven terrain:** please be aware of uneven/slippery ground when walking on track and in cemetery, and wear suitable footwear for ground conditions
- ❖ **Electric fencing:** fencing may be electric, please treat as if it were live
- ❖ **Tap Water:** water from tap at the cemetery site is not suitable for drinking

### General

Visitors to the cemetery are **not** permitted to wander to other areas of the farm unsupervised.

All farm vehicles, machinery, tools and equipment are strictly off limits to visitors.

No Alcohol or Drugs are permitted on farm

Do not leave gates open

Do not climb on fences/gates

Do not approach livestock
